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An Open Letter to Seminar Attendees:

Dear Attendee:

Welcome to today's presentation, titled, "The Problem With Prophecy." Because notetaking might be difficult, I felt the need to share my notes with you in the form of this lengthy open letter. I also wish to clarify some of the terminology I will use. With denominationalism having splintered Christianity, and with most denominations believing that they practice the faith once delivered, and with me believing that until Christ returns Christians only know the mysteries of God in part (1 Cor 13:9), I use the phrases "spiritual Israel" and "spiritual Israelite" for everyone who identifies himself or herself as a Christian. Just as the ancient kingdom of Israel divided into the house of Israel (the northern kingdom of Samaria) and the house of Judah, so too did the early Church divide into two competing theologies, one of which has been as lost as the descendants of the northern ten tribes. Thus, I identify Christians and denominations holding the theological position of Bishop Arius as the spiritual House of Israel, for reasons I will discuss in the seminar. I identify Christians and denominations holding the position that God is a Trinity as the spiritual House of Judah. Real war was fought between the ancient houses of Israel and Judah. Real war was fought from the 5th through the 7th Centuries between the spiritual Houses of Israel and Judah. Vandals were Arian Christians. Mormons today are Arian Christians. And war will again soon be fought between spiritual Israel and Judah. So while it is easy to dismiss Arian Christians as not genuine, understand that prophetically they will leverage food into a short-lived victory. Also understand that from the perspective of prophecy, God is as interested in Arian Christians as He is in Trinitarians. All of spiritual Israel (i.e., both Houses) will be liberated in a future Passover when spiritual and physical firstborns not covered by the blood of the Lamb of God will be killed.

This brings me to the subject of a pre-Tribulation rapture: most Evangelical Christians today find in Scripture support for Christ removing His disciples from earth prior to the beginning of seven years of tribulation. If, though, the visions of Daniel were sealed and secret until the time of the end, then these visions couldn't be understood by any earlier generation than the one living in the actual time of the end. The Apostle Paul thought he would live until Christ returned. The Apostle John thought he was living in the time of the end. Both would have thought they could have understood Daniel's vision of what would happen at the end of the age; both received visions themselves. But Daniel was greatly loved by God, yet understanding wasn't given to him. Likewise, understanding wasn't given to anyone living in the 1st Century, or in the 4th, or in the 19th, or in the 20th if God uses human language somewhat the way we do. Either we believe God that Daniel's endtime vision of what would become of Israel was sealed and would remain secret until that generic period identified as the time of the end began, or the Most High God has a credibility problem which nothing recorded in Scripture will resolve. The time of the end begins when the visions of Daniel can be understood. In true Catch-22 fashion, the visions of Daniel can be understood when the time of the end begins. But how will anyone know when either occurs? This is the first problem with prophecy. And this problem extends into the Book of

Revelation, which isn't sealed because the time is near (Rev 22:10 & 1:1). But "near" isn't two millennia in the future. So what was near? John was in vision on the Lord's Day, the day when the kingdoms of the world become the kingdoms of the Most High and of His Christ (Rev 11:15 & Dan 7:9-14). The vision John receives doesn't occur until Day 1260, halfway through seven years of tribulation. So the Book of Revelation has been as sealed as the visions of Daniel, for the Lamb of God doesn't remove the seals of the scroll until John sees the vision on the Lord's Day. The end of the age is near when only 1260 days remain; we aren't there yet. Thus, what the angel tells John about not sealing the vision is appropriate, for all of humanity is liberated from spiritual bondage to Satan when the kingdoms of the world become the kingdoms of the Most High.

There is a second problem with endtime prophecies: they are mostly about phenomena that occur in the spiritual realm. The image Nebuchadnezzar saw in vision was of the spiritual aspects of the succession of earthly kingdoms representing the time of the Gentiles. He was the head of gold; he praised the Most High God. He was not far from worshiping only the Most High. Likewise, what King Cyrus decreed about building a house for the Most High in Jerusalem (Ezra 1:2) indicates that the Persians kings had what we would regard as spiritually precious qualities although not to the same extent as Nebuchadnezzar had, while Alexander and the Greeks had the spiritual qualities of a penny. Real problems now enter. Rome does not represent the two legs of iron.

Christendom is awash with prophecy experts, each claiming that the two legs of the image Nebuchadnezzar saw in vision are the two divisions of the Roman Empire, that the image's bronze belly and thighs were the ancient Greek kingdom of Alexander the Great, that the arms and chest of silver were the Media Persia kingdom, and that the image of which Nebuchadnezzar was head is the record of the secular empires that have ruled the world. However, these experts have inserted an uninspired history book into Scripture. In Daniel's writing, we find the overturning of the Babylonian reign by Darius the Mede (Dan 5:31), and in Daniel's vision that takes place near Susa, Daniel sees a ram that the angel Gabriel identifies as the Media Persia empire (Dan 8:20) trampled by a he-goat identified as the king of Greece (v. 21). Daniel identified Nebuchadnezzar as the head of the image he saw, so without leaving Daniel, we can say for certain that the silver chest and arms are Media Persia, and the bronze belly and loins are Greece. Now, staying in the inspired visions of Daniel, we see the first horn of the king of Greece broken, and from that break comes four horns (Dan 8:22 & 11:4). From these four horns come the king of the North and the king of the South (Dan 11:5-6), not the Roman Empire. Remember, Babylon was a theocracy, as evidenced by the story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. The Media Persia reign was a theocracy, as evidenced by what caused Daniel to get thrown into the lions' den. Alexander's mother claimed he was the son of god. So the fourth kingdom, Greek in origin but divided from its conception, is the competing reigns of the kings of the North and of the South, the spiritual entities that empower two competing theocracies, one that becomes Christian, one that becomes Islamic. The angel who brought Daniel the endtime vision of what happens to Israel had to fight against the princes of Persia and would have to fight against the prince of Greece. So behind these theocracies is angelic power.

Without leaving the Book of Daniel, we see that the four world-ruling kingdoms are Babylon, Media Persia, Greece, and the severed reign of the kings of the North and of the South. Rome is not mentioned. The division into the two legs of Nebuchadnezzar's image occurs during the king of Greece's reign. So every prophecy experts who identifies the two

legs of iron as the Roman Empire, which doesn't divide until the 4th-Century AD, misreads prophesy and are false, harsh words, but true considering the damage their prophetic readings will do to spiritual Israel when Satan comes on Day 1260 as the true antiChrist. He is not the man of perdition, who is the demonic king of the North possessing an Arian Christian, and who will be destroyed on day 1260 (Dan 7:11-12).

We can now return to a pre-Tribulation rapture: if the Book of Daniel was sealed and secret until the time of the end, even though it contained everything needed to interpret itself, and if the Book of Revelation is sealed until the Lamb of God opens the scroll on the Day of the Lord, then no one earlier than in the time of the end could understand endtime prophecies. What all of this means is that biblical experts who find Rome or the Roman Empire in the prophecies of Daniel and Revelation do not understand the endtime mysteries of God, even though they can be or have been greatly loved by the Most High and His Messiah. Daniel was greatly loved, but understanding was kept from him. Thus, their readings of endtime prophecies cannot be trusted, and should not be trusted. In this sense, they are false prophets, a harsh identification for which I do not apologize because of the damage that will be done to the spiritual House of Judah, who has made no preparations for the forthcoming food shortages. The spiritual House of Israel will leverage food, which they already have in storage, and the distribution channels of food, which they also control, into spiritual victory over Trinitarian Christianity. Acceptance of the doctrine of a pre-Tribulation rapture will leave you hungry, and willing to accept "another" Christianity in order to satisfy your flesh. *YHWH* wasn't pleased with Esau when he sold his birthright for a bowl of porridge.

The false prophets who identify Rome as the two legs of the image Nebuchadnezzar saw have been inspired by the spiritual king of the North, not by Christ or the Father who told Daniel two and a half millennia ago that the visions were sealed and secret until the time of the end. They have set you up to first become an Arian Christian, then if you do not sucker for that scam, to accept the antiChrist as the Messiah when the man of perdition is destroyed halfway through seven years of tribulation, when the armies surrounding Jerusalem are destroyed by Christ as He fights on a [indefinite article] day of battle (Zech 14:4). The split Mount of Olives is the stone cut without human hands that destroys the image Nebuchadnezzar saw. This is the earth swallowing the armies of the beast that Satan borrows when he is cast from heaven on Day 1260 (Rev chpt 12 & Exod 15:12-17). This is when the 144,000 saints of physical Israel enter a place of physical safety in physical Mount Zion. Spiritual Israelites in spiritual Jerusalem, a theological location not a geographical location, will be protected in place. They go nowhere geographical. Instead, they burrow even farther into covenant with the Father, who wrote His laws on their hearts and minds (He didn't write His laws on their hearts and minds to have them ignore the fine print). So yes, there is a place of safety for spiritual Israelites. It is doctrinal, not geographical.

I have been drafted to read these prophecies of Daniel. I have been given understanding that I didn't have before, but I haven't been given additional visions or prophecies. Rather, everything humanity needs to understand the mysteries of God was given when Revelation was written. My task is not to add to what has been given, but to explain as best I can the prophecies that were sealed for two and a half millennia. My understanding is better today than it was a year ago when the visions of Daniel were first unsealed. But my task actually seemed easier then than now, for with the additional understanding has come knowledge that spiritual Israel includes both the spiritual House of Israel and the spiritual House of

Judah. It was easier not to worry about those so-called Christians who hold what I perceive to be theological errors than it is to love them enough to admit that they have a relationship with Christ. It isn't the amount of truth that each of us holds that is of ultimate importance. It is whether we do what we know is right, thereby establishing in our character the habit of always choosing to do right. Hypocrisy sends spiritual Israelites into the lake of fire. Christ will not be mocked.

I wasn't seeking disciples when I began this work for which I was drafted. Some will level this accusation against me, but if I desired disciples, I wouldn't go about acquiring them this way. My writings are confrontational. I am, perhaps, less so in person, but I have been given a hard head to do this job of confronting both the spiritual House of Judah and the spiritual House of Israel, both houses not understanding endtime prophecies, and not expected to understand them until they were unsealed. Christ, as the Lamb of God, would have all spiritual Israelites under His blood on that future Passover night when firstborns, spiritual and physical, are slain.

Most of my writings are posted on my Website. Again, they are confrontational, deliberately so. Spiritual diplomacy died before Christ, as the second Adam, named the animals (*Hypocrites, Vipers*, etc.). As with the first Adam, the names He called them will be their names forever. So the harshness with which I write is probably of God. Now that's a thought which will take a little contemplation.

I invite you to copy whatever you wish from my Website, to ask questions, to remember those things with which you disagree. If you do not have access to a computer, write and I'll try to answer your questions. Understand, though, by faith I believe unto obedience. This is what I teach as a way of life, so I will tell you that when you look at yourself in the mirror of Scripture, you should see Christ looking back at you. You were called to a spiritual Judean, not a spiritual Gentile. You will know a spiritual Israelite by his or her fruit: a second reason why the spiritual House of Israel will prevail over the spiritual House of Judah in the forthcoming war is because of the fruit borne by the House of Israel. You cannot run with the Gentiles and be right with God. Christ will turn His hand against two of every three Christians, or seven of ten in the parable of the pounds (Zech 13:7-8 & Luke 19:14, 27). With more than half the world's population having self-identified themselves as Christian during the first half of the Tribulation, this turning of His hand will be against a third of the world's population. But the other third of those who identify themselves as Christian will be in covenant with Him, suggesting that there will be a billion genuine Christians available to harvest the other half of humanity. This means that a lot of work remains to be done during this time of the end, and this means that you need to be appearing more Christ-like every day. You won't be going anywhere for a while, so you might as well get started.
